Some of these accomplishments for the year have been:

- 1) 6 states, including Massachusetts. have passed a new Equal Pay Law,
- 2) 19 AAUW members were elected to state legislatures, as Senators and Representatives,
- 3) There were over 200 Equal Pay Day Events nationwide,
