Best-Selling Local Author Jane Healey January 13, 7 pm via Zoom

This year we have chosen, *The Women of Arlington Hall*, by Jane Healey. It is a compelling tale of espionage and cryptoanalysis taking place in Washington D.C. during the early Cold War era. The protagonist uses her intellect and savvy to decipher intricate code ensuring the safety of our country. She, too, deals with the misogyny of the male dominated FBI.



This is the seventh book of historical fiction written by the former journalist, Jane Healey. 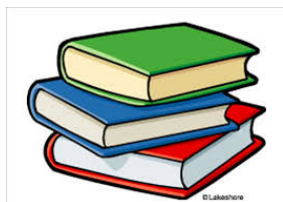
